

1998-99 FLORIDA BASKETBALL RECAPS

1 Florida 76, Georgia Southern 62 November 16, 1998 • O'Connell Center, Gainesville, Fla.

For the first time in school history, the Gators started four freshmen...The Gators' first 23 points all came from freshmen, and the freshmen five combined to score 66 of Florida's 76 total points...UF utilized a 19-5 run in the early going to build a 23-12 lead with 9:57 remaining in the first half...Georgia Southern would get within 10 points only twice the rest of the way...The Gators forced 18 turnovers in the first 20 minutes and converted them into 24 points...For the game, UF scored 33 points off 28 Ga. Southern give-aways...The victory marked the Gators' eighth consecutive win on opening day and third in three tries under Billy Donovan...It was also the Gators' 12th consecutive win in home openers...UF stands 56-24 overall in season-openers...Donovan improved to 5-0 on opening day.

2 Florida 82, Florida State 66 November 20, 1998 • Leon County Civic Ctr., Tallahassee, Fla.

Greg Stolt hit three three-pointers in a span of 85 seconds in the second half and added a pair in a 36-second span seven minutes later to give UF a 20-point cushion with five minutes left to play...Stolt's 5-of-6 three-pointer showing came after an 0-for-8 start from the field on the year (including 0-for-7 from three-point range)...The game returned to a campus site for the first time since 1995 and was played the night before the in-state football game...The win was the second consecutive in the Leon County Civic Center for the Gators, and the 16-point victory margin was the largest for UF in the series since a 17-point win in 1990...UF won its first road contest of the season after waiting until January 19th last year to win its first road game (vs. Jacksonville).

Florida won its 13th straight at home in the month of November...A 14-0 run late in the first half propelled the Gators to a 46-27 halftime lead as Bethune-Cookman was limited to just one field goal over the final 9:33 of the opening stanza...The two teams combined for an O'Connell Center record 63 turnovers in the game...For the contest, Florida scored 31 points off 33 Bethune-Cookman turnovers...Mike Miller scored 20-plus points for the second time in his first three games to join Livingston Chatman as the only freshmen in UF history to score 20-or-more twice in their first three games.

Florida forced 26 Charleston Southern turnovers, including 19 in the first half to improve its mark to 5-0 for the second consecutive season...In the opening stanza, the Gators limited CSU to just six field goals and only three buckets over the final 17:32 of the half...UF held its fifth straight opponent under 70 points, while scoring 80 or more for the fourth consecutive game...Five Gators were in double figures, led by Greg Stolt who provided a game-high 19 points in 23 minutes off the bench...Stolt had a perfect first half, going 4-for-4 from the field, including two three-pointers...Ladarius Halton had his fifth consecutive game in double figures with 13 points...Brent Wright recorded a career-high six steals, all in the first half.

December 9, 1998 • Cameron Indoor Stadium, Durham, N.C.

In the Gators' first trip to fabled Cameron Indoor Stadium, Duke utilized a 12-0 run midway through the first half to forge a double-digit lead and went into halftime with a 63-41 advantage...After yielding just 22 three-pointers in its first five games, Florida allowed 16 from beyond the arc which was the most ever allowed by a Gator team...Duke's 116 points tied the most ever scored by a UF opponent (Tennessee, Jan. 11, 1979)...Florida tallied 80 or more points for the fifth consecutive game which is UF's longest such streak since the 1986-87 season when the Gators scored 80 or more for nine straight contests.

With the victory, Florida coach Billy Donovan improved to 16-2 versus non-conference opponents at the O'Connell Center and 10-0 against teams from the state of Florida at home...Teddy Dupay had 19 points in the second half to finish with a game-high and career-best 24...Dupay also connected on a new team season-high 10-of-10 from the free throw line, including 7-of-7 in the final three minutes to put the game out of reach...The Gators had a season-best 19 steals...Brent Wright tied his career-high with nine rebounds...UF hit 30-of-38 free throws for a 78.9 percentage, both season-bests...The Gators were held without a three-pointer in the first half for the first time since December 16, 1995 (vs. Florida State), a stretch of 87 games...For the game, UF connected on just three trifectas (3-of-18) for a 16.7 percentage, both season-lows.

Greg Stolt broke the Florida career three point record with his fourth and final trey of the night and finished with a team-high 19 points...UF also set a new school record with 25 steals and broke the 100-point barrier for the second straight contest and fifth time in the Donovan era (11th time overall)...Ten Gators scored in the first half en route to 65 points at the intermission which tied as the second-best first half output in school history and third-best half overall...In the win, Florida also set season-highs for free throws made (40) and free throws attempted (50)...Udonis Haslem recorded his third double-double in only his ninth game as a Gator; it was his sixth consecutive contest with double figure points...The victory allowed UF to match its best start since the 1993-94 Final Four season.

Gonzaga edged the Gators to advance into the West Region final against No. 1 seed Connecticut...The Bulldogs' Casey Calvary provided the game-winning point, leaping over UF's Brent Wright and tipping in a missed shot with 4.4 seconds left...The tight contest featured 14 ties or lead changes in the second half...Florida had one last chance, but Eddie Shannon's desperation three-pointer at the buzzer was long...The Gators managed to keep the game close despite shooting 25 percent from behind the arc (6-of-24)...In the first half, Gonzaga built its biggest advantage, 26-13, before Florida stormed back to tie it at 27 with 3:11 left before intermission...The Gators finished the season with the fourth best win total (22) in school history and were just the sixth UF team to win 20 games...The 22 wins for Billy Donovan were the most wins by a Florida coach in his third year with the program...The Gators concluded the season as the second most improved team in the SEC, with an eight-win improvement over the 1997-98 campaign...Florida finished the year ranked 23rd in the AP Poll, becoming only the second UF team (1993-94 squad) to be ranked in the final AP...Five Gators finished the season averaging double-figure points for the first time since the 1989-90 team and only the fourth time in school history.
