Junior Year (2010-11)

Appeared in every game (35) ... earned 16 starts ... scored in 32 games... collected at least one rebound in all except one game, with a career-best 13 at Georgia (Jan. 16) ... UF's third-leading scorer in SEC games with 8.6 points and third-leading rebounder (4.9 rpg), while averaging 24.1 minutes compared with 3.1 points and 11.2 minutes in non-conference games ... **in two SEC TOURNAMENT GAMES**, tied for team-high in scoring (12.5 points) and rebounding (6.0 rpg) ... **in the LAST 5 GAMES**, averaged 11.2 points and 5.4 rebounds, while dishing 15 assists with seven steals ... tallied 17 points with three assists in the win at FGCU (March 21) ... in the upset of No. 22 Georgia (Feb. 27), scored 10 points with nine rebounds and four assists, the last two coming in the final 2:32, with the first coming after a steal and the final dish to Jennifer George with 48 seconds remaining that gave UF a 72-71 lead ... scored five of her six points in the final 8:36 of the win at Vanderbilt (Feb. 25), hitting a three-pointer in the middle of a 7-0 run ... nailed a three-pointer with 20 seconds left that tied the game in regulation against Vanderbilt (Feb. 6) and helped send it into overtime, as she scored a career-high 18 points on 7-of-16 shooting, with 4-of-5 from beyond the arc ... sank a three-pointer with 4.5 seconds remaining against Ole Miss that brought UF within one, but the Gators' late rally fell two-points short ... drilled what was nearly the game-winning three-pointer with 23.2 seconds remaining and gave UF a one-point lead against No. 19 Kentucky (Jan. 20), which hit two free throws to win it; scored a team-high 13 points on 5-of-8 shooting versus the Wildcats ... became the fifth different Gator to tally a double-double this year when she recorded career and team-highs of 14 points and 13 rebounds at Georgia (Jan. 16) ... became the eighth different Gator to lead UF in scoring in a game, when she tallied 12 points on 5-of-9 shooting in her SEC debut against No. 22/24 Arkansas (Jan. 2) ... sparked UF against No. 25/23 Florida State, scoring 10 points on 5-of-8 shooting in 15 minutes ... singled out by Coach Butler for sparking the team in its tight win against Navy (Nov. 27), dishing two assists and collecting three steals with her first three-pointer of her career and three rebounds ... scored first points in a Gator uniform came during the season-opening win against UCF, converting a layup with 4:55 remaining in the game ... hampered during the preseason with a hip flexor injury that limited her practice time ... 10 double-figure scoring games (most recently 17 points at FGCU, March 21)

Spent her first two collegiate seasons at Pensacola Junior College, where she averaged 19.2 points and 6.4 rebounds per game during her sophomore year in 2009-10, when she helped the Lady Pirates finish eighth in the National Junior College Athletic Association's National Poll with a 24-6 record ... led the country in scoring for 14 weeks during the 2009-10 season ... recognized as a 2010 WBCA and State Farm Coaches' All-America Team Honorable Mention performer ... named the Florida Community College Athletic Association Player of the Week on January 12, 2010, after leading PJC to victories against No. 4 Northwest Florida State and No. 10 Tallahassee, averaging 26.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.5 steals ... led the Lady Pirates in scoring during the 2008-09 season, contributing 14.2 points per game ... named the 2009 Lady Pirate Team MVP and voted First-Team All-Panhandle Conference ... coached at PJC by Chanda Rigby, who has guided a number of other Lady Pirates to Division I scholarships.

Lanita Bartley is a dynamic, scoring point guard and brings experience to the position, having spent the last two years playing in the Florida Junior College system for two years which is consistently the most competitive in the country ... very crafty with the ball and uses her body extremely well ... quick, athletic player

Junior Year (2010-11)

Started at point guard for 33 of 35 total games ... played in all 35 games, setting UF record for most played by a junior ... only Gator to start each of the first 18 games ... came off the bench for the first time at Georgia (Jan. 16) ... only Gator who scored in every game ... scored, collected at least one rebound and dished at least one assist in every game ... **IN LAST 3 GAMES: 10.7 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 3.3 assists pg, 55.6% FG (10-18) and 10-13 FT (76.9%)** ... UF's third-leading scorer overall (8.1 ppg) and fourth-leading scorer in SEC games (8.4 ppg) ... team leader in assists (118, 3.5 pg), steals (61, 1.8 pg) and trips to the free throw line (132, 3.9 pg) ... tied for ninth in SEC league games for assists and seventh in conference games for free throw percentage and steals ... dished her 100th assists of the season with her first of four in the upset win against No. 22 Georgia (Feb. 28) ... in the three-point win against No. 22 Georgia (Feb. 27), hit one of two free throws on with 9.4 seconds remaining and ended the game's scoring ... helped UF earn its first win vs. Vanderbilt in Nashville since 2004 when she scored 15 points with six rebounds and a career-high seven assists and converted all four of her free throw attempts in the final 13.6 seconds of the game to seal the victory ... exploded for a career-high 23 points leading UF to the win versus Mississippi State (Feb. 20), hitting 9-of-12 from the floor and 5-of-6 from the free throw line with eight rebounds and taking team-high scoring honors for the first time in her career ... scored a then-career-high 16 points against Vanderbilt (Feb. 6), as she hit 8-of-11 free throws, dishing three assists and collecting a game-high five steals ... came up with a huge offensive rebound off a missed free throw in the win at Mississippi State (Jan. 30) and was able to work the clock and eventually was fouled with 37.1 seconds to go; she missed those two free throws, but connected on two with 21.7 seconds remaining that made it a two-possession game in the seven-point win; also during the game nailed a huge three-pointer (just her sixth of the season) and gave UF a 58-50 lead with 4:26 on the clock ... scored five consecutive points during an 8-2 run midway thru the second half against Alabama (Jan. 27) that extended UF's one-point lead to 54-47; also converted two free throws with 1:03 remaining that gave UF a seven-point lead in the six-point win ... made the game-winning defensive play in the 65-63 win at South Carolina (Jan. 9), as she stole the inbounders pass underneath UF's basket and converted a three-point play with 16.7 seconds remaining for the game's final scoring, contributing nine points on 3-of-4 shooting and 3-of-3 from the line, as well as three assists and two steals in 21 minutes ... dished a career-high six assists with five rebounds in the win against Providence (Dec. 4) ... ignited UF's comeback win against Old Dominion, scoring six points in the final 5:03 remaining when the Gators ended the game on a 16-4 run and she finished with 10 points and a then-career-high four steals ... snared a career-high 10 rebounds versus South Alabama (Nov. 26), with six on the offensive end ... impressive Gator debut, scoring 12 points on 4-of-8 shooting and 4-of-4 from the free throw line to go along with four steals and four rebounds ... scored first points in a Gator uniform on a slashing layup with 13 minutes remaining in the first half of the season-opening win against UCF ... 10 double-figure scoring games (most recently 14 points vs. Tennessee, March 4)

Prior to UF (2008-10)

Spent her first two collegiate seasons at Santa Fe College located in Gainesville, Fla. ... recognized to the 2010 WBCA State Farm Coaches' All-America Team Honorable Mention for JC/CC and earned 2010 Florida Community College Activities Association (FCCAA) First Team All-State honors after guiding Santa Fe College to consecutive Mid-Florida Conference championships for the first time in more than 20 years ... honored as the 2010 MFC Player of the Year, leading the league in scoring with 17.8 points, the fourth-highest in the state; also ranked fourth in the state for assists and fifth for steals ... set the SFC record by converting 18 free throws against Florida State College-Jacksonville on Jan. 13, 2010, when she also established the new program standard with 22 attempts ... during the 2009-10 campaign, Bartley continued her assault on the Saints' record book, topping the chart for free throws made (186 in 28 games) and attempted (251 in 28 games), in addition to setting the program record for career free throws made (272) and attempted (363) ... twice honored as the National Junior College Athletics Association Player of the Week twice, the first time coming on Jan. 6, 2010, four days after becoming the second player in SFC history to record a triple-double ... on Jan. 2, 2010, Bartley totaled 23 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists in the win against Middle Georgia College, when she also collected seven steals in the game, just three shy of producing a quadruple-double ... second double-double was against Florida State College-Jacksonville on Jan. 31, 2010, when she contributed a career-high 37 points, with 10 rebounds and 11 assists, after which came her second national weekly honor ... SFC's leader in scoring her sophomore campaign, averaging 17.8 ppg while totaling 498 in 28 games, as well as contributing team-bests of 5.3 assists (149 total), 3.3 steals (92 total) ... collected 6.2 rebounds (174 total, 69 offensive), the second-highest average during the 2009-10 season ... converted 74 percent from the free throw line and 43 percent overall (144-337), in addition to hitting 24-of-83 from the three-point arc ... during her initial year at SFC, helped the Saints to a 22-6 overall record and win the Mid-Florida Conference for the first time since the 1984-85 season ... averaged 10.9 points (250 total in 23 games), the fourth-highest mark on the squad, with 5.0 rebounds (166 total), 3.6 assists

(83) and 2.0 steals (46) ... averaged 77 percent from the free throw stripe (86-112) and 42 percent from the floor (81-193) ... coached at SFC by Chanda Stebbins, a former Gator basketball and volleyball letterwinner.

UF's leading scorer in the championship game of Dead River Company Classic win over Navy (Nov. 28), recording 11 points on 4-of-8 shooting, with 2-of-5 from three-point arc and three assists ... twisted her left ankle with 4:35 remaining in the first half of the game at DePaul (Nov. 18) and did not return; also missed the next game as a result ... absence at DePaul was felt, as she had scored six points on a pair of treys in 11 minutes and the Gators lost by one ... impressive collegiate debut during the season-opening win against UCF, as she scored 10 first-half points en route to a team-best 15 points on 4-of-7 shooting, in addition to converting 5-of-8 free throws and collecting four rebounds ... scored first points in a Gator uniform from the free throw line against UCF, connecting on both with 15:21 left in the first half; her first field goal was a 3-pointer versus the Knights, draining the first of back-to-back treys with 12:20 remaining in the opening frame ... 17 double-figure scoring games (most on the team; most recent was 23 points at Charlotte, March 24)
