



# UAA LIFE SKILLS CUP CHAMPIONS

THE 2007-08 GATOR WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM EARNED THE UAA LIFE SKILLS CUP FOR THEIR COMMITMENT TO HELPING OTHERS ON CAMPUS AND IN THE GAINESVILLE COMMUNITY.



The "Goodwill Gators" program was recognized by the National Consortium of Academics and Sports and received the 2000-01 and 1997-98 Outreach and Service Award. Last year 348 UF student-athletes participated in 1,877 hours of community service, partnering with 43 schools, 27 civic organizations and 19 non-profit organizations.



## UAA LIFE SKILLS CUP AWARD

As a part of the CHAMPS Life Skills program, the University Athletic Association (UAA) sponsors the UAA Life Skills Cup award. This award is presented annually to the team that excels the most in the five areas of the CHAMPS Life Skills program. Teams earn points for participating in any Life Skills programming including but not limited to: SAAC, Goodwill Gators (community outreach), workshops and presentations. Coaches that participate earn double points for their teams.

Each month, the total earned points are updated and the teams are arranged in rank order. At the end of the academic year (fall to summer), the team with the most points is declared the winner and announced at the annual Welcome Back Reception in the fall.
