Games (starts): 29 (12)

• A redshirt junior who has thrown for 2,665 yards and 19 touchdowns as a Gator.

2010 Season:

Games (starts): 12 (12)

• Is 194-of-316 on the season with 2,020 yards, nine touchdowns, and a completion percentage of 61.4.

• Went 6-of-12 for 52 yards at Florida State and threw a 20-yard touchdown pass to true freshman Robert Clark, while also starting at wide receiver for the first time in his career.

• Went 16-of-22 for 222 yards against Appalachian State, including his first career touchdown reception, a five-yard grab from Jordan Reed.

• Recorded a quarterback rating of 148.40 against Appalachian State, the second-highest of his career. His highest (171.04) was against Vanderbilt.

• The last time a starting quarterback had a receiving touchdown was in 1998, when Doug Johnson caught a 10-yard reception from wide receiver Travis McGriff against Georgia on October 31, 1998.
