Series and Game Notes

The two Sunshine State schools first met on the gridiron in 1958 in a series that has become one of the nation's most spirited rivalries ... Both teams have been ranked in the top 10 at gametime in each of the last 13 meetings ... Florida posted a 21-7 victory in that first showdown, and the Gators and Seminoles have met every year since that initial contest, with Florida now holding an overall 26-17-2 lead in the series standings.

Florida State's first win in the series came in 1964, 16-7, in what was the first meeting between the two squads in Tallahassee ... The first six contests in the series were held in Gainesville ... Since 1964, the series has alternated between the two campuses, with Florida hosting in odd-numbered years and Florida State in even-numbered years ... Two games have taken place at the

Sugar Bowl, after the 1994 and 1996 seasons.

Since 1979, this game has been the scheduled regular season finale for both universities ... In the 1990s, this series went beyond the regular season as the two schools faced off in the Sugar Bowl in a rematch of the regular season twice (1994 and 1996 seasons) ... Following the 1996 season at the 1997 Sugar Bowl the Gators downed the Seminoles, 52-20, in New Orleans to claim their first national championship ... UF has defeated the Seminoles twice (1997 Sugar Bowl and 1997 regular season finale) in the last four meetings when Florida State was ranked number one in the nation.

Prior to the last few years, this series was marked by streaks for one school ... Florida won nine straight from 1968-76 ... Florida State then won four consecutive games from 1977-80, Florida responded with six straight from 1981-86, and the Seminoles then put together a 6-1 record from 1987-93 ... FSU holds a 5-3-1 edge in the last nine meetings, including wins in each of the last three contests.

Florida and Florida State are the only two schools in the nation to rank in the Top 15 in the final polls in each of the last 11 seasons (1990-2000) and the only two schools in the nation to play in a January bowl game in each of the past eight seasons (1993-2000) ... Steve Spurrier is 4-8-1 against the Seminoles, while FSU head mentor Bobby Bowden is 15-11-1 against the Gators ... Spurrier was 2-1 against the Seminoles as the Gators' quarterback from 1964-66.
