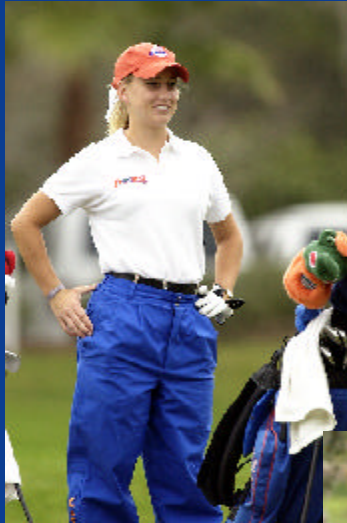
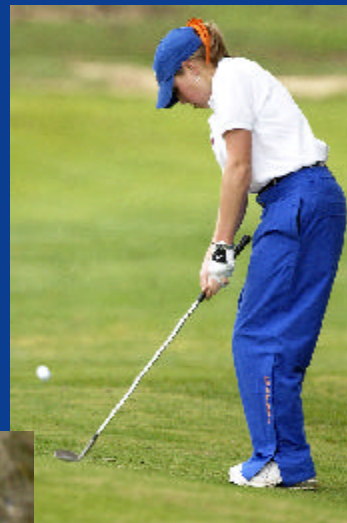

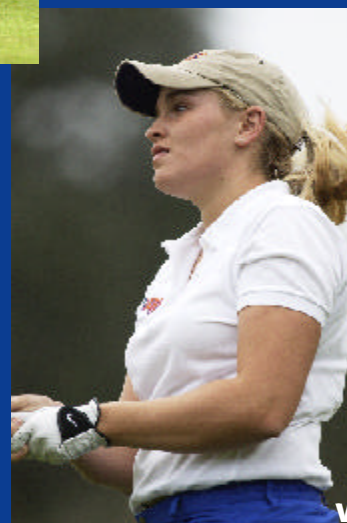

### Gators Finish Tied for Sixth at NAAs

The Florida Gator women's golf team finished its season Friday tied for sixth at the 2002 NCAA Championships, shooting a final-round 295 to finish with a four-day total of 1179. The Gators' finish is the team's best national finish since Florida was the runner-up in 1998. Duke claimed the team title, followed Auburn, Texas and Arizona in a three-way tie for second place.

"I'm very proud of this team. We've worked hard all year," said Head Coach Jill Briles-Hinton. "At the start of the season, I don't think anyone expected us to be in contention."

"We stayed focused and committed to our goals, and in the end we played the way we knew we could. We're a young team. This past week's experience at the NCAA Championships is invaluable to our maturing process. We will be back next year."

Florida began the day paired with fellow SEC members Georgia and Auburn, and the Gators made the turn at hole 10 at just one-over-par. **Brittany Straza** made the turn at two-under-par after making birdies on holes five and seven. **Jeanne Cho** began her round with a bogey on the first hole, but birdied the ninth hole to make the turn at even-par, as did **Whitney Code**, who birdied hole six and bogeyed hole seven. **Andrea Vander Lende**, who entered the day with a two-under-par 214, moved to hole 10 at three-over-par, and **Amanda Dick** made the turn at four-over-par.

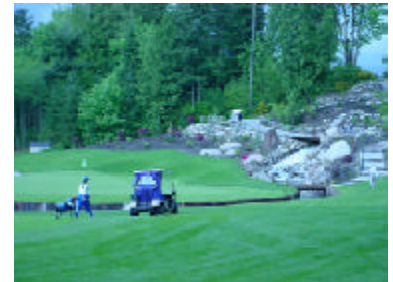
Vander Lende carded a four-over-par 76 on the day, finishing the tournament in 12<sup>th</sup> place with a 290. Cho followed, shooting a two-over-par 74

to finish the Championships with a 296 to tie for 31<sup>st</sup> place, while Straza shot even-par over the final nine holes of the tournament, finishing with a 70 to tie for 41<sup>st</sup> place with a four-round 297. Code finished right behind Straza, carding a three-over 75 on the final day to tie for 45<sup>th</sup> place with a 298.

Dick rounded out Florida's scoring with a final-round 81 to tie for 107<sup>th</sup> with a four-day total of 312.

"I'm really excited and happy with my first year," said Vander Lende. "I think my teammates have pushed me and made me better. I think next year will be even better for us."

Vander Lende, who was honored after the tournament for finishing 12<sup>th</sup>, was the only freshman to finish in the top 15.

### Gator Bites

- With its sixth-place finish at the NCAA Championships, Florida has jumped to No. 6 in Golfstat's latest ranking, marking the highest ranking for the Gators this season.

- Individually, Jeanne Cho is ranked 35th in *Golfweek's* latest ranking, while Brittany Straza is ranked 41st.

- The Gators' finish the season with three wins, the most since the 1995-96 season.

- The Gators' 878 at the NCAA East Regional is the fifth-best team three-round team score in Florida history.

- This year's squad ranks fourth in Gator history in lowest average team scores per three-round tournament at 903.9 strokes per event.

- With Florida's 1,179 total strokes, the 2001-02 team ranks third in school history in lowest average team scores per round (300.53), just behind the 1986 national championship team, which averaged 299.19 per round.

- Florida's four-round total of 1,179 strokes is the second best NCAA Championship score in school history, one stroke better than the 1986 national championship team.

- Andrea Vander Lende put together the best three-round total of her career during the first three

rounds of the NCAA Championships, shooting a two-under-par 214. Her previous best total was 223 at the NCAA East Regional.

- Vander Lende was the only freshman to finish in the top 15 in this year's Championships.

- Cho and Whitney Code were named to the NGCA All-American Scholar Golf Team at the conclusion of the Championships.

- Florida has improved more than 10 strokes per round from last season, when the Gators averaged 311.1 strokes per round.

- The Gators' 878 at the NCAA East Regional is the fifth-best tournament total in the program's history.

- UF finished last season ranked No. 40 by *Golfweek* and jumped to as high as ninth in that same ranking this season after its win at the Liz Murphey Collegiate when the Gators defeated No. 1-ranked Auburn by one stroke.

- UF's win in the SunTrust Lady Gator Invitational is the Gators' second win in three years in their home tournament, and it marks the 12th time in the tournament's 30-year history that Florida has claimed the title.

- Cho and Straza were named Second Team All-SEC on April 19, while Vander Lende received Honorable Mention honors as well.

- Cho, Straza and sophomore Joy Stephenson were named to the SEC's Academic Honor Roll. All three are repeat selections.

- Cho, who won the individual title at the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic, was named the SEC

Women's Golfer of the Week on March 27 for her performance in that tournament.

- Five Gators have tallied a total of eight top-10 finishes and 28 top-20 finishes in tournaments this season.

- Five players have also shot even or under par rounds 20 times this season, which include five scores under 70.

- Cho's scoring average has improved more than two strokes since the beginning of the season, and she leads the team with a 74.97 stroke average.

- Cho also leads the team in rounds counted with 92 percent (31.25 of 34) of her rounds counting toward the team score.

- Cho and Vander Lende earned All-State honors by finishing in the top five of the Florida Women's Collegiate April 5-7.

- Vander Lende and Code were named to *Golfweek's* "Freshmen to Watch" list prior to the beginning of the season.

### Head Coach Jill Briles-Hinton

Jill Briles-Hinton recently completed her fourth season at the helm of the Lady Gator golf program. Briles-Hinton was hired on June 18, 1998 after spending 12 years on the LPGA Tour. Briles-Hinton played collegiate golf at the University of Miami where she was an academic All-American. For the second time during her tenure at Florida, the Gators advanced to the NCAA Championships.

While at Florida, Briles-Hinton has coached five players who were named to the SEC Academic Honor Roll 10 times. Junior Jeanne Cho was named to the Verizon Academic All-District Team for the past two years and is now eligible for the national award. Cho and Whitney Code were just named to the National Golf Coaches Association's All-American Scholar Golf Team.

In addition, four golfers were named All-SEC a total of seven times under Briles-Hinton. Three players also earned All-State honors four times during her tenure.

Briles-Hinton is assisted by Robin Walton, a 1978 graduate of the University of Washington. Walton has served on the LPGA Board of Directors and also served on the Executive Committee of the LPGA (1986-87), where she oversaw field staff operations and the LPGA Junior Golf Clinic Program.

Florida began the day paired with fellow SEC members Georgia and Auburn, and the Gators made the turn at hole 10 at just one-over-par. **Brittany Straza** made the turn at two-under-par after making birdies on holes five and seven. **Jeanne Cho** began her round with a bogey on the first hole, but birdied the ninth hole to make the turn at even-par, as did **Whitney Code**, who birdied hole six and bogeyed hole seven. **Andrea Vander Lende**, who entered the day with a two-under-par 214, moved to hole 10 at three-over-par, and **Amanda Dick** made the turn at four-over-par.

Vander Lende carded a four-over-par 76 on the day, finishing the tournament in 12th place with a 290. Cho followed, shooting a two-over-par 74 to finish the Championships with a 296 to tie for 31st place, while Straza shot even-par over the final nine holes of the tournament, finishing with a 70 to tie for 41st place with a four-round 297. Code finished right behind Straza, carding a three-over 75 on the final day to tie for 45th place with a 298. Dick rounded out Florida's scoring with a final-round 81 to tie for 107th with a four-day total of 312.

"I'm really excited and happy with my first year," said Vander Lende. "I think my teammates have pushed me and made me better. I think next year will be even better for us."

Vander Lende, who was honored after the tournament for finishing 12th, was the only freshman to finish in the top 15.
