Freshman Mallory Blackwelder returned to her home state of Kentucky and won the individual medal at the Lady Wildcat Invitational.

Team Highlights

- Florida advanced to the NCAA Championships for the 19th time in 25 years, finishing tied for sixth overall. It was Florida's 16th top-10 NCAA finish in the 25-year history of the event and the fourth under Head Coach Jill Briles-Hinton
- Reached the NCAA Regional for the seventh consecutive season and the 13th time in the last 14 seasons
- As a team, Florida registered victories at the Lady Wildcat Invitational, Lady Puerto Rico Classic and the SunTrust Lady Gator Invitational
- The team also recorded a pair of runner-up finishes.
- Florida players carded 24 even or under par rounds, which was 10 more than last season
- The Lady Gators had 14 top-10 individual finishes. Sandra Gal led the team with six finishes in the top-10
- Florida had a pair of individual medalist winners. Mallory Blackwelder returned to her home state and won the Lady Wildcat Invitational, while Sandra Gal took first place at the SunTrust Gator Invitational
- By placing fourth at the NCAA Championships, Gal became the sixth golfer in school history to secure a top-five finish.
- The Lady Gators finished in the top 10 at the NCAA Championships for the fourth time under Jill Briles-Hinton

Individual Highlights

Mallory Blackwelder

- Third on the team with a 75.91 stroke average in 37 rounds
- Played in all 13 tournaments
- Won the individual medal at the Lady Wildcat Invitational during her second collegiate tournament
- Was the low Gator at the Mason Rudolph Invitational and the Lady Wildcat Invitational
- Carded a season-low round of 68 at the Lady Wildcat Invitational
- Had four rounds at even or under par

Tiffany Chudy

- SEC Academic Honor Roll
- Second on the team with a 75.83 stroke average in 31 rounds.
- Finished third at the Chrysler Challenge
- Carded a season-low 69 during the first round of the NCAA Championships
- Finished the season tied for 12th at the NCAA Championships

- NGCA All-America Honorable Mention.
- Second-Team All-SEC
- SEC Academic Honor Roll
- Finished the season ranked 40th in the Golfweek/Sagarin rankings
