Outline of Commitment

AS A PROSPECTIVE MEMBER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA MASCOT PROGRAM, I UNDERSTAND THAT I MUST ADHERE DILIGENTLY TO THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS OR RISK THE CHANCE OF SUSPENSION OR REMOVAL FROM THE SQUAD.

1. I am a full-time student at the University of Florida and have a 2.5 or higher G.P.A., semester and cumulative.
2. I am in good standing with the University of Florida and am not on academic or disciplinary probation.
3. I have no health or physical defects which would hamper my ability to perform as a mascot or which might cause my performances to be unsafe to my health.
4. I am covered by adequate health insurance to cover any cost of accident or injury that may occur during auditions, practices, or any time I am a member of the University of Florida Mascot program.
5. Any costs not covered by insurance will be my personal responsibility.
6. It is imperative that the training room is notified in case of emergency treatment or if I consult a doctor or medical attention on my own record. I clearly understand UAA insurance coverage is void should I choose outside medical attention.
7. Due to athletic acrobatic and the nature of mascot performances at the collegiate level, it is required that squad members maintain, their physical condition at the time of their selection of the squad. Failure to adhere to this standard will result in suspension.
8. All squad members are subject to the same drug testing policies and procedures as University of Florida student-athletes.

MASCOT GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Being a mascot must come second to academics and takes precedence over any other extracurricular activities.
2. Eligibility will range from January 2007-April 2007.
3. All traveling decisions will rest upon coordinator, supervisor, and the University Athletic Association, Inc.
4. All appearances/games during holiday breaks and spring break must be covered and all mascots will share appearance responsibilities throughout the holidays. Personal holiday trip scheduling must be cleared by coordinator.
5. Mascots must enjoy working with children.
6. Mascots should be comfortable adapting to extreme temperature conditions (ex. Soccer and Football games during hot months of the year).
7. The mascots will appear at approximately 300-400 events per year. This averages out to approximately 4-5 appearances per mascot per month.
8. Mascots must have driving capabilities to transport to and from appearances.
9. Being a mascot is a time consuming activity, so mascots should be well-organized.
10. Mascots receive 1-2 complimentary football tickets per home game, based on availability from UAA ticket office.
11. Mascots receive partial scholarships per year based on years of service, as well as partial scholarships through the Mr. 2 Bits Golf Tournament held each fall semester.
