UF advances to the NCAA Round of 16 for the 21<sup>st</sup> time in the last 22 years ... UF caps home season with a perfect 11-0 record, the 18<sup>th</sup> undefeated home slate in program history ... UF improves to 145-1 all-time at home versus SEC teams ... Saturday marked the third meeting this season between Florida and Auburn, with the Gators winning all three to improve to 30-0 in the all-time series ... Auburn ends its season in NCAA Second Round to an SEC team for second straight year (lost to Georgia in 2007)
