On-court temperature at start of 11 a.m. match was 80 degrees ... the two team split in their two meetings of the 2003 season, as Washington defeated UCLA 6-1 on April 12 ... the Bruins are now 5-4 this season in matches decided by a 4-3 score ... UCLA is now 11-3 all-time vs. the Huskies ... the Bruins will make their second-consecutive and 15th appearance overall in the NCAA Quarterfinal Round ... UCLA meets Duke on Friday at 10 a.m. in the quarters... this was the Huskies second trip to the NCAA Round of 16 since the 2001 season.
