## FOUR EASY WAYS TO ORDER SINGLE GAME TICKETS

1. Order online at [www.Gatorzone.com/tickets](http://www.Gatorzone.com/tickets). This is the most convenient method to place a single game ticket order. *To create or access your personal account: Step 1: Go to [www.Gatorzone.com/tickets](http://www.Gatorzone.com/tickets) and select "Manage My Account". Step 2: Log in to your Personal Account with your Account I.D. and password. Step 3: Manage your tickets.*
2. Order by calling one of our Ticket Office Specialists at (352) 375-4683, ext. 6800, or toll free (800) 344-2867, ext. 6800, Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
3. Order by visiting us at the Gator Ticket Office, located at Gate 1 of Ben Hill Griffin Stadium, Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

## HOME SINGLE GAME TICKETS

Home tickets are sold on 'first come, first order' basis until sold out. Seat assignments will be based on the best available at the time of order.

**There are NO single home game tickets available for TENNESSEE or FLORIDA STATE.**

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL TICKET HOLDERS

- **Payment of Tickets:** Payment may be made by personal check, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover. The person whose name is on the order MUST pay for the order. If payment is made at the Ticket Office, verification of identity is required for acceptance of the order. The Gator Ticket Office discourages payment by cash. **THESE SAFEGUARDS ARE NEEDED TO ASSURE CONTRIBUTORS THAT PRIORITIES ARE BEING USED BY THE PROPER PERSON AND WILL NOT BE PASSED ON TO INELIGIBLE USERS.** *Ticket price includes state sales tax.*
- **Disabled Seating:** Limited reserved handicap seating is available at Florida Field. Please indicate this requirement on your order form.
- **Disabled Parking:** Beginning with the 2008 Football season, the University Athletic Association, Inc. adopted a new Football game day reserved disabled parking plan. This process is based on season ticket longevity, not on Booster priority points or contribution levels. All patrons must have a valid government issued handicap placard to be eligible. Non-reserved public disabled parking is located at Garage IX, on the south side of the Archer Road and Gale Lemerand Drive intersection. This garage will be serviced with disabled accessible shuttles every 15 minutes, dropping fans off at Gate 18. These shuttles begin 4 hours prior to kickoff and run until 1 hour after the game. Contact the Operations Office at (352) 375-4683 ext. 6042 with any questions or to add your name to a waiting list.
- **Sitting Together:** Due to time constraints there may be times when it will not be possible to accommodate requests for sitting together. The Ticket Office will limit these requests to NO MORE than two orders. Both ticket holders must note on their order form with whom they wish to sit.
- **Address Changes:** If your address changes after you have placed your ticket order, you should contact the Gator Ticket Office, **in writing with signature**, immediately. Tickets are mailed First Class and should be forwarded to the new address by the US Postal Service if you have made the necessary arrangements. If your order form was forwarded to you, please contact the Gator Ticket Office, in writing with signature, as soon as possible to update your record for future mailings. Fax to: (352) 372-5801.
- **Stadium Admittance:** ALL persons regardless of age MUST have a ticket for admittance.
- **Selling of tickets by non-UAA personnel on UF Campus IS NOT ALLOWED.**
- **Reselling of Tickets:** Due to the limited supply and very high demand of tickets for season, away and post-season games, many do not have the opportunity to purchase tickets. If for any reason you find that you will not be able to use your tickets for a particular event you may call the Gator Booster Office at 352-375-4683 ext. 5071 and we will be glad to offer your tickets at face value to other Gator Booster members who are trying to obtain tickets. The UAA does not condone the reselling of tickets for profit. Tickets are the property of the University Athletic Association, Inc. and if a ticket holder is abusing his/her ticketing privileges the University Athletic Association, Inc. reserves the right to revoke them.
- **UF Students:** UF Students who will be enrolled in 12 credit hours (6 for graduate students) in the fall are eligible to purchase student season tickets. To purchase, students must enter the season ticket lottery. Registration takes place from April 20 to June 5, 2009 via [www.Gatorzone.com](http://www.Gatorzone.com).

## AWAY GAME TICKETS

### PRIORITY DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, MAY 29, 2009

#### TICKET ASSIGNMENT:

Away game ticket eligibility is determined and assigned based on the point system, regardless of club level. A donor receives one (1) point for each \$100 of contribution to Gator Boosters toward football, and five (5) points for each consecutive year of ordering season tickets. If the Gator Ticket Office is unable to fill your order or must limit the number, you will be notified.

**LIMITATIONS:** The Booster priority membership limits the number of tickets to allow as many of our season ticket holders the opportunity to travel to away games. Any order that exceeds these limitations will be adjusted accordingly and appropriate refunds or credits made.

To be filled within the Gator Booster Priority Point System, your Away Game order **MUST** be received by **May 29, 2009**. **THE POSTED DEADLINE DATE IS FOR AWAY GAME TICKET ORDERS ONLY.**

## FLORIDA - GEORGIA TICKET POLICY

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY



#### Reserved Seats @ \$40 per ticket:

- **ONLY** current season ticket holders **who received Georgia tickets in 2008** may reorder the same number of tickets. Increases in orders **WILL NOT** be accepted. (If you reduce your order, you will be limited to that quantity in the future.)
- **NEW 2009 Bull Gators may order up to six (6) tickets @ \$40 each, based on availability**
- **NEW 2009 Grand Gators may order up to two (2) tickets @ \$40 each, based on availability.**
- Therefore, new 2009 season ticket holders from the Scholarship Club level and below **CANNOT** order Georgia tickets.

#### Club Seats @ \$70 per ticket:

- **ONLY** Bull Gator, Grand Gator and Scholarship Club members **who received Georgia Club tickets in 2008** may reorder the same number of tickets. **Increases in orders WILL NOT** be accepted.
- If you ordered club seats in 2008 and were reduced to \$40 tickets, due to demand you cannot order club seat tickets but may order the same number of \$40 tickets as in 2008.
