SEC Volleyball Notes

- The 2010 season marked the 21st consecutive season in which the SEC placed at least two teams in the NCAA Tournament. The SEC landed six teams in the NCAA Tournament: Florida Gators, Kentucky Wildcats, LSU Tigers and Tennessee Lady Vols, Auburn Tigers and the Ole Miss Rebels.
- The Florida Gators captured the No. 1 national seed, marking the first in school history and in SEC history.
- Florida captured its 19th SEC title in 2010.
- LSU claimed the Western Division crown in 2010 for the sixth consecutive season.
- Seven student-athletes were named to ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District teams for a total of 63 all-time.
- Tennessee's Nikki Fowler was named CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine First Team Academic All-America, while Mississippi State's Kayla Woodard was named Third Team.
- The 2010 All-SEC teams had all 11 schools represented, marking the first time since 2000 this has happened.
- Florida has extended the nation's longest streak of consecutive 25-win seasons to 20.
- The SEC earned three AVCA All-America honors in 2010: Kelly Murphy (UF), First Team; Nikki Fowler (UT) and Regina Thomas (UM), Third Team. This marks the third overall AA honor for Murphy, first First Team selection, and the first AA honors for Fowler and Thomas.
- Six SEC student-athletes earned 2010 AVCA All-America Honorable Mention honors.
- The SEC has 56 total AVCA All-Americans (First, Second or Third Team).
- Florida Head Coach Mary Wise recorded career win No. 700 in 2010. She is the winningest coach in SEC volleyball history.
- UF's Kelly Murphy leads the nation in triple-doubles with six.
- The SEC had three AVCA National Players of the Week in 2010.
- Tennessee's Nikki Fowler holds the league career record for SEC Player of the Week honors with eight. The previous record was seven by former UF All-American, Aury Cruz.
- Florida's Mary Wise was named AVCA South Region Coach of the Year.
- The SEC had 12 individuals named to the 2010 AVCA South All-Region Team, including three honorable mentions.



Team-by-Team Notes



ALABAMA Crimson Tide - Alabama wrapped up its 2010 season with a win at home against Mississippi State 3-1 to finish the season at 11-19 overall and 3-17 against SEC opponents.

Sophomore Kayla Fitterer led the Crimson Tide with her 11th double-double of the season contributing 18 kills and 13 digs. Freshman Brianne Vande Griend also had double-figure kills with 14, while senior Mary Catherine Aune collected a career-best 23 digs.



ARKANSAS Razorbacks - Jasmine Norton and Raymariely Santos earned All-SEC accolades when the league announced its postseason awards last week.

Norton was named to the All-SEC Second Team while Santos earned a spot on the SEC All-Freshman Team. It marks the second career second-team selection for Norton and Santos is the third all-freshman performer for Arkansas under head coach Robert Pulliza.



AUBURN Tigers - The Auburn volleyball team concluded its history-making season this past weekend in the second round of the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

The Tigers traveled to Lincoln, Neb., and opened the tournament with a match-up against Missouri State on Thursday at the NU Coliseum on the campus of the University of Nebraska. Auburn topped Missouri State in three sets, 3-0 (25-15, 26-24, 27-25). Sophomore Sarah Bullock led all attackers with 12 kills, while senior Morgan Johns finished with 10 kills to lead the Tigers.



FLORIDA Gators - The University of Florida volleyball team capped off one of the finest seasons in program history with its 19th NCAA regional semifinal appearance in the last 20 years.

The Gators finished the 2010 season with a 29-2 record, marking the program's most victories since the 2007 campaign, and earned the first NCAA Tournament No. 1 seed in the program's history. Florida became the first Southeastern Conference team to win the league with a perfect 20-0 record since the implementation of a double round-robin format prior to the start of the 2006 campaign.

ninth all-time in program history in career assists. Bledsoe, junior outside hitter Kristy Jaeckel and Rivers each earned AVCA Honorable Mention All-America honors for the first time in their careers. Florida finished the season as the SEC's leader (all matches combined) in blocks per set (2.84), service aces per set (1.64) and hitting percentage defense (.159).



GEORGIA Bulldogs - The Georgia Bulldogs concluded the 2010 season with an overall record of 15-17 and a conference record of 6-14 finishing fourth in the Eastern Division and eighth overall.

Through the end of October, Georgia stood at 11-14 and then head coach Joel McCartney was relieved of his duties as assistant coach Chad Hanson assumed interim head coach duties going 4-3 in November to close out the season. The end of the 2010 season also marked the end of the collegiate playing careers for two Bulldogs, seniors Valentina Gonzalez and Simone May.



KENTUCKY Wildcats - The Kentucky volleyball team dropped a hard-fought four-set contest to No. 16 overall seed Purdue in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament (25-18, 24-26, 25-17, 25-18).

Senior Lauren Rapp led the way for the Blue and White with 10 kills and three blocks in her final collegiate match. Freshman Whitney Billings added six kills and a team-high seven digs in the loss. Setter Christine Hartmann had a career-high seven kills and led the team with five blocks in the match.



Team-by-Team Notes



LSU Tigers -LSU had its 2010 season come to a close with a 3-0 setback to No. 22 Tulsa last Friday during the NCAA Tournament First Round at Oklahoma's McCasland FieldHouse. With the loss, the Tigers ended their season with a 25-5 record. The defending six-time SEC Western Division champions have reached the 20-win plateau in five of the last six seasons. Tulsa rode the right arm of Tyler Henderson, the nation's leader in kills per set, to 26 spikes to collect the win. LSU was paced by Desiree Elliott, the SEC Freshman of the Year, who smacked nine kills on a .364 hitting percentage and added five blocks. Michele Williams knocked eight kills followed by Madie Jones with six kills. However, the duo was held in check to a combined .064 ratio. On the back row, Lauren Waclawczyk reeled in 10 digs for her 17th consecutive double digit dig performance. Meghan Manari and Sam Delahoussaye tacked on six and five digs, respectively. Brittney Johnson handed out 26 assists to go along with six digs and four blocks, while Angela Bensend finished with five kills and six digs. At the net, Tania Schatow tacked on three blocks. It was the final match in Bensend, Johnson and Schatow's careers. LSU is one of only 18 programs to participate in the each of the last six NCAA events and are scheduled to return 11 letterwinners for the 2011 season. OLE MISS Rebels - Ole Miss wrapped up the 2010 season over the weekend in the NCAA Tournament with a loss to the North Carolina Tar Heels in the first round of action played on the campus of the University of California. It is the third NCAA Tournament appearance all-time for the Rebels and third in the past five seasons. Ole Miss also advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2006 and 2007. The Rebels finished the season with a 19-11 overall record and a 13-7 mark in Southeastern Conference play to finish fourth in the SEC overall standings and second in the SEC Western Division. Ole Miss will lose two seniors off of this years squad with middle blocker Miranda Kitts and setter Emily Kvitle. Kitts finished her career with 286 total blocks (56 BS, 230 BA) to finish eighth all-time in total blocks at Ole Miss. She also put down 656 kills in her career. Kvitle was named to the SEC Community Service Team for the second consecutive season in 2010 and finished her career with 917 assists and 698 digs as she split time as a setter and defensive specialist in her four years in Oxford. Junior middle blocker Regina Thomas finished the season with a .421 hitting percentage on the year and sits seventh nationally in hitting percentage in 2010 and hit .451 in SEC matches only to lead the league by a large margin. Thomas missed the final seven matches of the year due to injury and will return to the lineup in 2011 along with sophomore Courtney Cunningham who was also lost to the Rebels because of injury this season with only eight days of competition under her belt. Junior libero Morgan Springer also broke the 1,000 dig mark for her career this season and holds 1,201 digs through three years with the Rebels. Springer sits second on the all-time list at Ole Miss for digs behind Tara Langley.



MISSISSIPPI STATE Bulldogs - Mississippi State dropped a 3-1 decision at SEC West rival Alabama to close out its 36th season of volleyball with an 11-20 record. The Bulldogs posted a 3-17 mark in league play, finishing tied with Alabama for fifth place in the SEC West ... Junior outside hitter Caitlin Rance recorded her team-leading 13th double-double with 14 kill and 10 digs. She concluded the campaign tops on the team with 403 kills (2nd-most in the SEC) and a .215 attack percentage and second with 254 digs ... Senior middle blocker Ashley Newsome recorded four blocks, raising her SEC-leading total to 137 blocks, third-most in a season. She also established the MSU career record for total blocks with 406 ... Senior Kayla Woodard notched her ninth 20-dig performance in her career finale, becoming the third MSU player to eclipse the 500-dig mark in a season (507). She finished third among MSU's career leaders with 1,433 digs. Woodard this week became the third player in MSU volleyball history to receive academic all-America honors, being named a third-team selection for the 2010 ESPN Academic All-America team ... Freshman setter Paris Perret became the 15th Bulldog overall and the third MSU rookie to register 1,000 assists in a season, tying for 11th with 1,024, third-most in the SEC



SOUTH CAROLINA Gamecocks - The Gamecocks closed out their season with a 7-23 overall record and a ninth-place showing in the overall SEC standings (4-16 SEC). Senior Hannah Lawing led the SEC in digs during the entire season and finished fractions behind Stephanie Klefot of Kentucky in the league-only stats. Juliette Thévenin stands as the only freshman in the league's top 10 in kills per set and is one of three SEC players in the top 10 in both kills and aces per set during league play. The Gamecocks will lose three seniors, two who were starters, while gaining two players back who were forced by injury to redshirt their first year on campus.



TENNESSEE Lady Volunteers - The 2010 campaign came to a close for the University of Tennessee volleyball team in the second round of the NCAA Tournament as it dropped a five-set heartbreaker to Indiana in Bloomington. The Lady Vols finished the season with a 25-7 overall record, marking the program's most wins since it went 32-3 in 2004. The Big Orange offense was the best in school history, posting a .291 hitting percentage to break the previous record of .286 set in 1980. UT will graduate three seniors in Nikki Fowler, Leah Hinkey and Emily Steinbeck. A three-time All-SEC First Team selection and two-time AVCA Honorable Mention All-American, Fowler ends her career among the top ten in seven Tennessee career categories. A native of Dallas, Texas, she ranks first all-time in total attacks (4,426), third in attacks per set (9.54), fourth in kills (1,649), sixth in kills per set (3.55), sixth in digs (1,281), seventh in digs per set (2.76) and eighth in blocks (344). Hinkey's name will also go down in the record books as she finished with a five-year total of 583 blocks, good for third in school history. Her 1.24 blocks per set average, meanwhile, places second behind only former teammate Sarah Blum's mark of 1.55. In her two years at Rocky Top, Steinbeck dished out 1,069 helpers and tallied 28 aces and 288 digs. Preseason All-SEC Team

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – The Southeastern Conference announced its volleyball coaches preseason All-SEC team to launch the 2010 season of SEC volleyball.

The preseason All-SEC team consists of a minimum of nine players, which are voted on by the league coaches. Ties are not broken. Florida, Kentucky and Tennessee led all schools with two selections each. In addition, Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia and LSU all had student-athletes named to the team. Tennessee's Nikki Fowler made her third consecutive appearance to the team, while eight of the players listed were named All-SEC First or Second Team in 2009.

In a class-by-class breakdown, five juniors earned honors, followed by four seniors and one sophomore. By division, the East had seven recognized, and the West had three.

The 2010 season gets underway on Friday, Aug. 27. SEC Conference action begins Sept. 17. The 2010 SEC Volleyball Preseason Poll will be announced on Wednesday, August 18.

Tennessee Voted to Win 2010 SEC Volleyball Title

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – The Tennessee Lady Vols have been selected to win the 2010 Southeastern Conference volleyball title in a preseason vote by the league's 11 coaches. This marks the first time since 1994 that a different team has been voted to capture the title, snapping at least a 16-year run at the honors for the Florida Gators. Coming off a 24-8 season and tied for second in the SEC East (16-4), the Lady Vols received nine of the 11 first-place votes.

Tennessee received 11 points to win the Eastern Division, followed by Florida with 21 points and Kentucky with 25. Georgia and South Carolina are picked to finish fourth and fifth in the division respectively. The Gators did receive two first-place votes for overall champion.

For the third consecutive season, the defending SEC Champion LSU Tigers are predicted to win the Western Division with 13 first-place votes. The Tigers posted an 18-2 league record and a 25-7 overall record. The Auburn Tigers have been selected to finish second with 19 points, and the Arkansas Razorbacks are predicted to place third with 25 points. Ole Miss and Mississippi State are picked to finish fourth and fifth, respectively, while the Alabama Crimson Tide rounds out the poll in sixth-place.

Points were compiled on a 1-2-3-4-5-6 basis for the Western Division and 1-2-3-4-5 for the Eastern Division. Each coach is not allowed to vote for his or her own team and each coach also voted for one team as an overall conference champion.

The 2010 season will get underway on Friday, Aug. 27. SEC conference play will begin Sept. 17.
