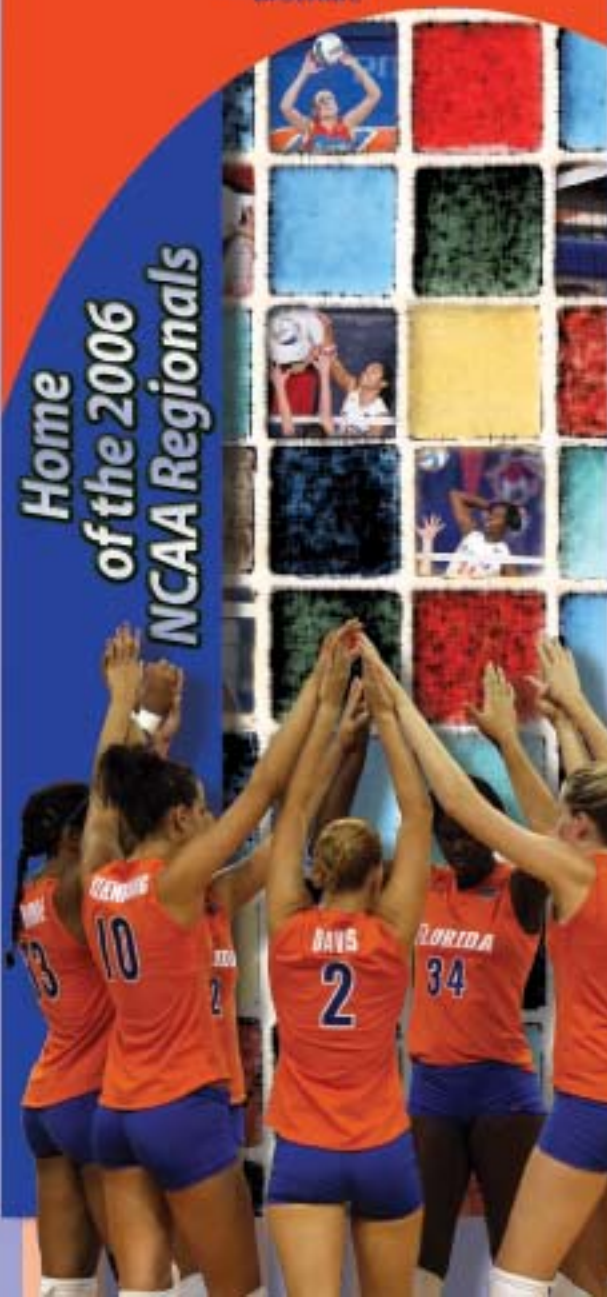

## 2006 GATOR VOLLEYBALL

The 2005 season was a very successful season for the Florida Gators. The squad claimed its 15th straight SEC regular season title - matching a conference record by any team in any sport - and also captured the program's 12th SEC Tournament crown in the last 14 years. The Gators advanced to the NCAA Regional Final for the 12th time in 15 seasons, which is the most in the nation, and finished the season ranked No. 3 in the AVCA Coaches Poll.

The 2006 squad has big shoes to fill, but with the return of 10 letter-winners, led by third team All-American and All-SEC First Team setter Angie McGinnis and a strong influx of young talent, this squad is ready to carry on the banner of volleyball excellence.

The Gators return several veterans including junior Amber McCray, All-SEC Second Team outside hitter, Marcie Hampton and AVCA Honorable Mention All-American middle blocker Kisyia Killingsworth, who will team up with McGinnis and middle blocker Kari Klinkenberg to form a formidable Gator attack.
